



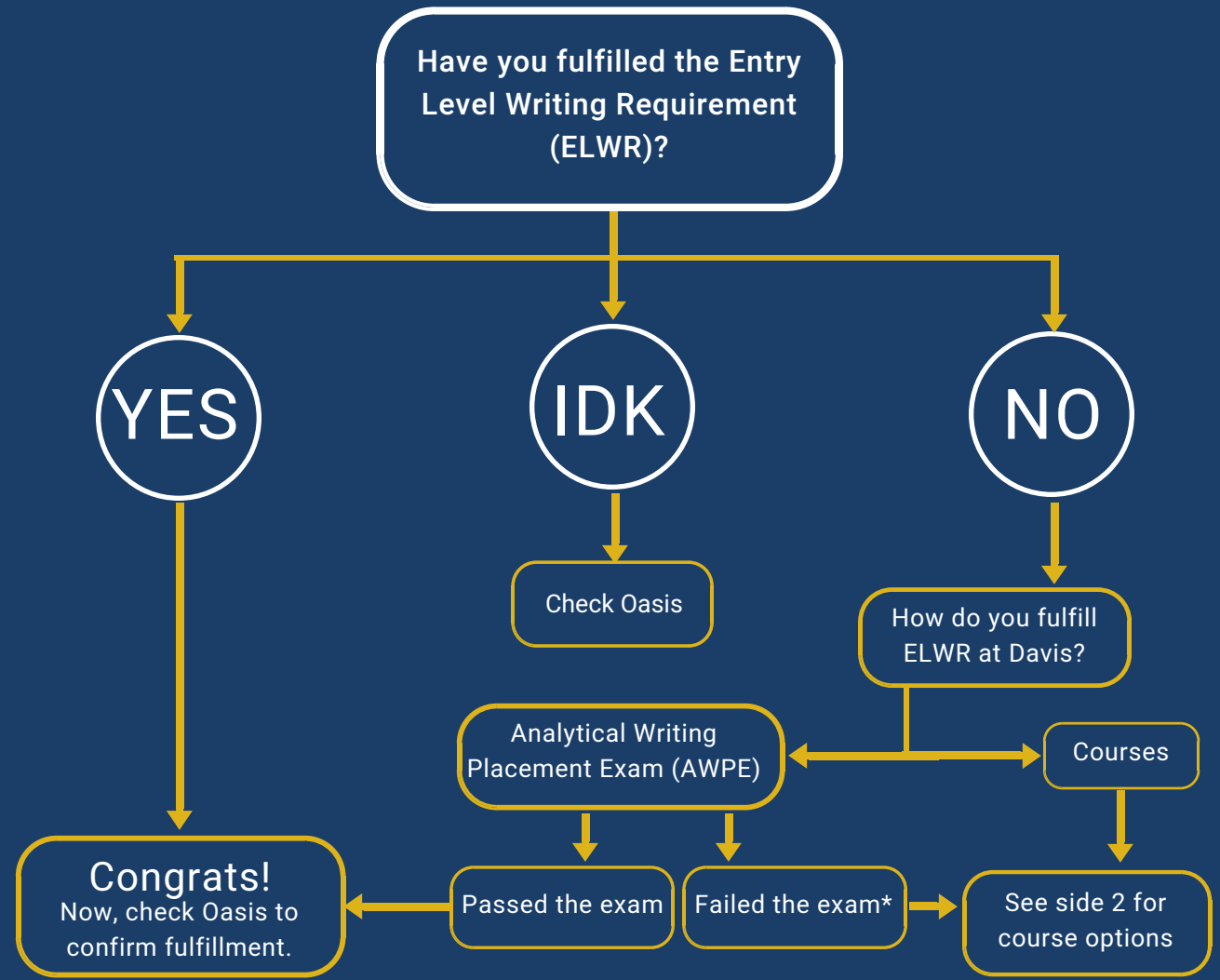

How to Fulfill ELWR at UC Davis

Note: Students cannot get credit for lower division composition requirement or Writing Experience (WE) credit until they complete the ELWR. Also, some international and multi-lingual students should check <https://iae.ucdavis.edu/undergraduate/elpe> to see if they should take the ELPE.

Standardized Test Scores used for Admission	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 30 or better on the ACT, English Language Arts; or ● 30 or better on the ACT, Combined English/Writing (last administered June 2015); or ● 680 or better on the SAT, Evidenced-Based Reading and Writing* (beginning with Fall 2018 admits); or ● 680 or better on the College Board SAT Reasoning Test, Writing (last administration January 2016)

AP/IB Test Scores	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 3 or above on either Advanced Placement Examination in English (Language and Composition or Literature and Composition); or ● 5 or above on an International Baccalaureate Higher Level English A: Literature exam (formerly known as Higher Level English A1 exam); or ● 6 or above on an International Baccalaureate Standard Level English A: Literature exam (formerly known as Standard Level English A1 exam); or ● 5 or above on an International Baccalaureate Higher Level English A: Language and Literature exam; or ● 6 or above on an International Baccalaureate Standard Level English A: Language and Literature exam

Analytical Writing Placement Exam (AWPE) Score	<p>The AWPE is a two-hour timed test offered to seniors in California public high schools every May. The AWPE may only be taken once per student. If you took the AWPE as a high school senior, your test results should appear in your admission information (https://myadmissions.ucdavis.edu/applicants/). Your results of the AWPE will not affect a student's admission to UCD. It is also offered once per quarter at UCD. Complete an Equivalent Course before Entering UCD	<p>You can transfer in credit earned before you entered UCD via a grade of C or higher in an acceptable 3 semester-unit or 4 quarter-unit English composition course to fulfill the ELWR. If you are transferring credit from a California community college, the course must be listed in Area UC-E under "UC Transfer Admission Eligibility Courses" on http://www.assist.org/ and must be completed before you matriculate into UCD. English composition courses completed at both in-state and out of-state institutions are evaluated by Admissions for ELWR fulfillment.</p>

Complete an Equivalent Course after Entering UCD	<p>Earn a C or higher in one of these courses at UC Davis:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● WLD 57: 4.5 non-credit bearing unit Sacramento City College course ● WR 39A: 4 unit UC Online course ● UWP 7: 4 unit UCD course (pilots in winter and spring 2019) ● A co-course (pilots in winter and spring 2019): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ ENL 3A: 2 unit UCD course (while also enrolled in ENL 3) ○ UWP 1A: 2 unit UCD course (while also enrolled in UWP 1) ○ NAS 5A: 2 unit UCD course (while also enrolled in NAS 5)
